With over 3,000 online visitor registrations to date and a targeted hosted buyer program covering the UAE and Eastern European markets, the organiser is confident of significant volumes of new business being initiated during the Fair.

Landscape Istanbul Fair will take place from 13-16 October in halls 9 & 10 at the Istanbul Expo Centre and is open daily from 10:00 -18:00 hrs except for the final day when the Fair opening hours are 10:30 – 17:30 hrs. Access is free of charge to trade visitors.
